The Coast Guard's portfolio of aviation acquisition programs will recapitalize the service's fixed- and rotary-wing aircraft fleets by delivering new and upgraded platforms – including the HC-144, HC-130J, MH-65E and MH-60T programs provide improved mission equipment and advanced operational capabilities to Coast Guard aircrews. Working closely with requirements sponsors and technical authorities, the Service is completing service life extension and upgrade work to maximize our aviation asset capabilities and longevity while minimizing lifecycle total ownership costs.



Commercially Available Polar Icebreaker

Coast Guard has requested funding to acquire a commercially available polar icebreaker, including modifications and integrated logistics support required to reach initial operational capability for Coast Guard operations. This vessel will provide a platform capable of projecting U.S. sovereignty and influence while conducting Coast Guard statutory missions in the high latitudes.

Coast Guard has initiated pre-acquisiition activities to support the planned acquisition of a new Great Lakes icebreaker to complement existing domestic icebreaking capabilities.
